PRESQUE ISLE RECONSTRUCTION – PHASES 2 AND 3 BEGIN

Beginning at 7 a.m. on Thursday, Aug. 17, Presque Isle Avenue at the Fair Avenue intersection will be closed to through traffic for Phase 2 and 3 reconstruction work. It is expected this intersection will be closed for approximately one week. With this work completed, a temporary bypass road will be available to allow traffic to travel through this intersection on the south side of Fair Avenue to Third Street.

The Presque Isle Avenue work will detour traffic from Presque Isle Avenue to Kaye Avenue, Third Street, Fair Avenue, Lakeshore Boulevard and Wright Street.

Businesses in this area are open and patrons can access them by way of the detour route to Wright Street and onward to Presque Isle Avenue. The public is advised to use caution when traveling through this area and to be alert for construction, detour and advisory signing.
