JUNE EXHIBITS: THURSDAY PAINTERS AND KIRK CIAGLASKI

The City of Marquette Arts and Culture Center announces its June LSAA Gallery exhibition: Thursday Painters, titled “Oldies and Newies, In Memory of Marjorie Carlson and Betty Schirtz.” This exhibit will feature paintings in acrylics, oils, alcohol inks, markers and watercolors by Helen Steinhoff, Shirley Michelson, Marjorie Carlson and Betty Schirtz. The Thursday Painters were organized over 60 years ago.

The SmallWorks Gallery and Peter White Public Library’s Huron Mountain Club Gallery features work by Kirk Ciaglaski. Ciaglaski was born and raised in southern Michigan and is now based out of Traverse City. During his younger days, he developed an interest in skateboarding, which changed the direction of his life for the next 10 years. Through skating, he was introduced to a sub-culture of art, music and other influences that impacted his entire perception of life. The friends he made through skating inspired him to experiment with photography, video, graphic design and painting. Kirk is widely traveled and has documented stories from his skateboard. The exhibit will include skateboards, photography and film.

The exhibits will run June 2-30, with an artist reception – held in conjunction with the City of Marquette’s annual Art Week – on Wednesday, June 28 from 6 to 8 p.m.
