DLZ Michigan, Inc. Awarded for the Marquette Hospital Transportation Improvements Project

Detroit, MI – On March 2, 2019, DLZ was presented the Engineering Honorable Conceptor Award at this year's American Council of Engineering Companies of Michigan (ACEC/M) Excellence Awards at Motor City Casino's Sound Board for the Marquette Hospital Transportation Improvements Project. The City of Marquette's Mik Kilpela and DLZ's Matt Hamel accepted the award.

DLZ was retained by the City of Marquette for this complex, tight scheduled design. The primary purpose of this project was to design and construct transportation improvements on US-41/M-28 and locally to accommodate the increased traffic due to the new Marquette Hospital. The project included three roundabouts, two stream crossings, and a flood control basin. DLZ also served as the primary coordinator between the City of Marquette, Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, and the Federal Highway Administration. Given that a majority of the project was on an MDOT route, MDOT was heavily involved and issued the final permit. DLZ's technical abilities and communication efforts were vital in completing the project to the highest standards.

Additionally, DLZ's recent acquisition, Johnson & Anderson, Inc., was presented the Engineering Merit Award for their design of the Port of Monroe Shipping Terminal in Monroe, MI.
