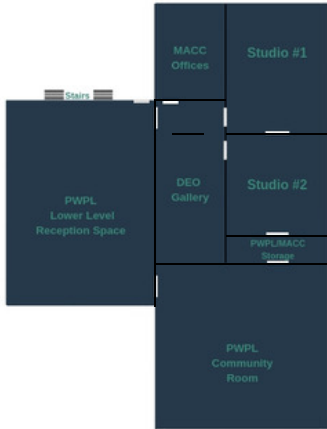
Studio #1
