### **Wednesday July 15, 2020/ Marquette Public Art Commission Meeting**

Due to Executive Order 2020-21, **Wednesday July 15, 2020**, The **Marquette Public Art Commission** meeting will be held virtually with Commission members and Staff attending remotely through Zoom video conferencing. The meeting will start at **6:30pm**. This meeting will be streamed on the City of Marquette YouTube channel (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofMarquetteGov>). Please note that the YouTube livestream will have at least a 20 second delay.

#### Public Participation

There will be three options for public participation in this meeting: video conferencing, phone conferencing or written comment. There will be two public comment periods for the meeting, one at the beginning and one at the end. Comments will be limited to three minutes and speakers must give their name and address. Written comments will be limited to 500 word

Members of the public wishing to call in and make a comment over the phone will need to call 312-626-6799 and enter the meeting ID 842 5613 1694

When participating via video or phone conferencing, you will be placed into a virtual lobby/on-hold until the Public Comment portions of the meetings are reached. Once Public Comment begins, the Chair will go through each person waiting in the lobby one at a time and provide them with the opportunity to address the Commission. It is recommended that participants follow the meeting on YouTube to know when the Public Comment portion is occurring and be ready to make their comment.

The video and phone conference lobby will open 10 minutes before the scheduled meeting start time.
