### Rules & Regulations

---

Pass this information on to everyone in your unit. It is the responsibility of each organization to ensure that their participants are informed of the rules, route and line-up information.

- All entries must check-in with the Parade Committee between 10:30am and 11:30am in the PEIF parking lot. Enter the lot off of Presque Isle. Upon checking in with the Parade Committee, you will receive a staging map identifying your space in the parade line-up. The parade will leave the PEIF parking lot and travel south on Third Street. **Only vehicles registered to participate in the parade may enter the line-up area. All other vehicles should be left in designated parking areas.**
- Participants on the float MAY NOT THROW candy or other items to people along the parade route. Candy and other items must be handed out to the crowd. This safety regulation protects spectators from potential injuries.
- Units must be decorated in keeping with the holiday. All entries must be constructed so spectators on both sides of the street can view them. This includes decorations and trim.
- When constricting units, be prepared for any weather condition that may exist during preparation and the parade itself.
- Vehicles and trailers must be inspected to make sure there are no mechanical problems before the parade begins.
- Upon inspection of the unit, the parade chair has the authority to limit the number of passengers who can safely ride on the float.
- No float and/or vehicle may be left unattended at any time while waiting for the parade to start.
- Children may not be left unattended at any time throughout the event.
- Unregistered entries will not be allowed to participate in the parade.
- All entries are encouraged to carry or display an identification banner in front of their float, vehicle or marching unit.
- Applicants assume all responsibility for loss or damage in connection with their entry.
- The Parade Committee reserves the right to disallow inappropriate entries.
- The Parade Committee, in conjunction with the Marquette Police Department, reserves the right to cancel the parade for any reason – including inclement weather.  
Cancellation/delays will be announced on radio and social media.
