Public Accuracy Tests are conducted in the Baraga Gym, while other meetings are held in City Commission Chambers – both are located in City Hall, at 300 W. Baraga Avenue.

Additional meetings may be called, and changes may be made in accordance with the City Charter. Notices will be posted for such changes in compliance with Public Act 267 of 1976.

Proposed minutes of meetings will be available for public inspection within 8 business days after the meeting. Approved minutes will be available for public inspection within five business days after the meeting at which minutes are approved.
