

Cliffs-Dow EPA Cleanup Grant Application

The City of Marquette is applying for a U.S. Environmental Protection Act (EPA) Brownfields Cleanup Grant to support remediation of soil and groundwater contamination at the former Cliffs-Dow property at Wright Street and Lakeshore Boulevard in the northeast portion of Marquette.

The application includes three primary components: Narrative Application, Threshold Criteria, and the Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives.
